MUSIC THEORY & FUNDAMENTALS

- Ability to play the C & F major, and D & E natural minor scales & arpeggios over 1 octave, starting from the 1st finger position
- Functional understanding of harmony major, minor chords and how they connect to scales.



EAR TRAINING

- Ability to sing different major and minor scales with only root as reference.
- Ability to sing the major and minor pentatonic scales.
- Ability to identify Octave, 5th and 3rd intervals by ear.
