## **MUSIC THEORY & FUNDAMENTALS**

- Introduction to the Chromatic scale
- Study of the Harmonic & Melodic Minor scales
- Understanding the musical styles of Pop & Musical Theater, Soul & R'n'B, Jazz & Blues, and Rock & Indie



#### **EAR TRAINING**

- Ability to identify and sing the intervals of a M7, m7, M6, m6 & m2
- Ability to pitch all the notes in a given chord (triads & 7th chords), when played on an instrument
- Ability to identify and pitch the notes of the chords: Aug, Sus2, Sus4, Dim7, Dom7, HalfDim7 & minmaj7



### TECHNICAL EXERCISES

- The ability to sing the Chromatic scale over 2 octaves, at 100 bpm
- The ability to sing the Harmonic & Melodic Minor scales, and the Cdim7 arpeggio at 100 bpm
- The ability to perform exercises associated with the stylistic studies of Pop & Musical Theater, Soul and R'n'B, Jazz & Blues, and Rock & Indie
- The practice of mixed/modal voices, melismas, vocal resonance & articulation
- The ability to harmonize a diatonic third or fourth, over a given melody
- The ability to improvise a simple tune over Harmonic Minor & Diatonic 7th chord sequences
- Demonstration of the use of a dynamic microphone and a condenser microphone



#### SIGHT READING

Sight-reading a 12 bar melody, featuring the intervals of m7 & M7, P5, m3
& M3, ranging over 2 octaves, and including rests, dots & ties



## **IMPROVISATION**

• Ability to improvise fluently with Blues, Diatonic and moderately complex non-diatonic and jazz chord progressions, in a variety of styles and feel.



## **SONG LEARNING**

- Ability to perform songs using a style-based approach
- Inclusion of vocal ad-libbing over 12-16 bars, and the reworking of melody lines over 8 bars



#### LIVE PERFORMANCE

• Regular performances at school/college/semi-pro/Taaqademy events



#### **MUSIC EXAMINATIONS**

• Completion of RSL Grade 7/8, or Trinity Grade 8 (based on ability/practice)

## **HOW LONG WILL THIS TAKE?**

This question gets asked a lot! Allow us to give you a simple rule-of-thumb:

- At this level, if you **consistently** practice an avg. **1 2 hr**. **per day**, you can expect to have covered the above in **10 12** months (**40 48 classes**).
- If you practice around 4 hrs. <a href="per week">per week</a>, this could add 4 5 months.
- If you practice <1 hr. per week, you could take 18+ months!
- Actually speaking, once you're at this level, you KNOW it takes forever. As in, your whole life. And that is good :-).
