RUDIMENTS

- Ability to play single strokes at 100 & 120 bpm
- Ability to play double strokes at 100 & 120 bpm
- Ability to play single paradiddles at 100 & 120 bpm
- Ability to play flams at 60 bpm



RHYTHM NOTATION

- Sight-reading four-bar phrases with quarters, eighths & sixteenths, played on the snare drum using single and double strokes
- Knowledge of, and sight-reading basic triplets



DRUM KIT EXERCISES

- Ability to play the Rock Shuffle beat at 60, 80 & 100 bpm, with a play-along track
- Ability to play 12/8 Blues beats at 60, 80 & 100 bpm, with a play-along track



SONG LEARNING

• Completion of at least 3 songs from RSL Grade 1

HOW LONG WILL THIS TAKE?

This question gets asked a lot! Allow us to give you a simple rule-of-thumb:

- At this level, if you **consistently** practice an avg. **30min 1 hr**. **per day**, you can expect to have mastered the above in **3** months (just **12 classes**) or less.
- If you practice around 2 hrs. per week, this could add 1 2 months.
- If you practice <1 hr. per week, you could take 6 months!
